Day 1: My Holy Vocation

O God, Creator and Ruler of heaven and earth, all creatures owe their existence to Your infinite goodness and fatherly love. You have appointed for each one of us the sphere in which, under Your direction, support and encouragement, we are to press onward to our final goal. I thank You Almighty God, for the vocation to which you have called me. I thank You for Your all-embracing, all-pervading, all-governing providence, which oversees all of the particular works of this vocation. I submit to Your dispensation. I resign myself to Your guidance. I grasp Your leading hand, and beg for the grace never to follow the way of my own inclinations. The fruit of Mildness, that I may subdue every rising of ill temper, stifle every murmur, and repress the susceptibilities of my nature in all my dealings with my neighbor;

The fruit of Fidelity, that I may rely with assured confidence on the word of God;

The fruit of Modesty, that I may order my exterior regularly;

Act of Consecration to the Holy Spirit
